According to Section 17d of the Tracking Regulations (Amended to January 1, 2016), tracks may be set aside for workers from previous tests. Up to two tracks will be set aside.

When the limit of 4 dogs for the TD Test and 3 dogs for the TDX Test have been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth above, shall be assigned a position on an Alternate List corresponding to the order in which they are drawn. The test secretary shall notify all entries of the result of the draw. If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limit for entries is exceeded in the other test, the proper number of tracks may be exchanged.

DRAWING FOR TD TRACKS will be at 8:00 AM April 7, 2019.

The TD Test will begin following the drawing for tracks. Drawing for TDX tracks will be at 10:00 AM April 7, 2019. The TDX Test will begin following the drawing for tracks.

An appropriate memento will be awarded to each dog successfully completing the test. Directions will be mailed to all exhibitors.

GENERAL INFORMATION

REFUNDS: No entry fees will be refunded except for an alternate that does not participate or in the event that an accepted entry withdraws after the closing in order to allow an alternate to replace said entry. In these cases, the entry fee shall be refunded within 7 days following the test. In the event that an accepted entry withdraws after the closing date and there is no alternate to replace said entry, the entry fee will NOT be refunded.

ENTRY FEE: TD \$65.00 (includes \$.50 AKC recording fee and \$1.50 AKC event service fee); TDX \$125.00 (includes \$.50 AKC recording fee and \$1.50 AKC event service fee). Entries close at 6:00 PM, Friday, March 22, 2019 at the test secretary's address, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted.

Bitches in season may participate, but must follow Chapter 2, section 8 of the Tracking Regulations. The test secretary and the judges must be notified prior to the drawing for tracks.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels(King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, A or B division.

3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3. of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.)

4. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants
