CLASSES OFFERED

Two rounds of ACT1 and two rounds of ACT2

- ACT1 is an entry-level test that is designed to introduce the dog and handler to the agility ring and basic agility obstacles in a fun, relaxed setting.
- ACT2 is the second level and is designed to introduce handler and dog to additional obstacles, including teeter and weaves.

ENTRIES

Fee per round..... \$10

- Limit of 70 runs for the day. Dog may enter any or all rounds.
- Two ACT1 and ACT2 rounds are offered, so receiving titles is possible on this day.
- Mail-in entries open on Monday, March 11, 2019 and close on Wednesday, May 8, 2019. **Send to: 4520 Winchester Rd Petersburg PA 16669**
*Day-of-event entries will **not** be accepted.*

WHO CAN ENTER?

- Any dog that meets the age and physical requirements for a regular AKC agility trial. Dog must be 15 months of age or older.
- **The dog cannot have earned any AKC agility title other than ACT titles. Your dog does not need an ACT 1 title to enter ACT 2. If your dog has an ACT 1 title, you may continue to enter ACT 1, if desired, until earning an ACT 2 qualifying score. A dog with an ACT 2 title can continue to compete in ACT 2 until earning a non-ACT AKC agility title.**
- Non-registered (can be registered day of event) or AKC registered dogs without registration numbers will be issued a temporary one after the event by the AKC office.
- If a dog/handler team has qualified at an event with an unregistered dog, they will be sent a query to register the dog after the event.

JUMP HEIGHTS

You may enter your dog at **any** jump height you wish.

PERFORMANCE AND TITLES

- ACT1 and ACT2 titles and certificates will be issued by the American Kennel Club to dogs that are registered with them.
- Qualifying and title ribbons will be presented by MNDTC.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations published for this event and any decision made in accord with them and further agree to be bound by this Agreement. I (we) agree that the club or ACT Evaluator, holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club or ACT Evaluator shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge or ACT Evaluator, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events.

In order to acquire the ACT1 or ACT2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club. AKC Canine PartnersSM applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results.

Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
