At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 shall be required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 shall be required for each additional entry of the same dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 5). All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS, Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The Show giving club and the Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise ring.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.
